Submission Criteria

2 Nominators per application are required.

Nominators can be: Members, leaders and parents. Nominators can only nominate one person.

Nominees can be: Anyone involved in an adult leadership role in the 4-H community. It may be a club leader, volunteer, a behind the scenes person, a grandparent, alumni or even someone on a committee or board. The volunteer cannot have received this award in the last 5 years. Contact the 4-H BC office if you are unsure if they have received the award previously. Ensure the volunteer's efforts are voluntary and not paid. Paid work cannot be submitted.

The individual will have:

- Demonstrated initiative, leadership and creativity in their service
- Served as a role model for others in their community
- Made a lasting impact on their community that has benefited others
- Inspired others to engage in volunteer service

The award winner will be announced on October 16 at the 4-H BC Leadership Symposium held in Vernon, BC. The recipient will receive attendance at the virtual National Leadership Summit in 2022 plus \$100 towards a celebration activity for their club, district or region.
